Your Adoption Assistance Program (AAP) account



A personal expense account allowing you to pay for eligible adoption-related expenses with **pretax** dollars



Your contributions are pretax and deducted from your paycheck to fund the account



Save money on these costs1

How your AAP Works

(like other spending accounts)



Enroll

in your company's AAP Plan



Estimate

how much money you need to put toward adoption-related expenses



Plan Wisely

any unused money will be forfeited at the end of the plan year



Select

how much money to withhold from each paycheck



Submit a Claim

reimbursement form and receipts via fax, mail, secured email, or the Further portal*



Reimbursed

you'll be reimbursed up to the available balance in your account**

^{**} Foreign adoption claim payments are limited to after the adoption is successful




You can use your AAP to pay for:

- Agency and placement fees
- Legal fees and court costs
- Reasonable travel and lodging expenses related to the adoption
- Medical expenses for the adoptive child prior to placement



Always save your receipts to ensure proper validation of expenses, as required by the IRS.




- Payments that aren't related to the adoption of an eligible child as defined by the IRS
